Consigning at the Creek

Q. Where is the sale located?

A. Our sale is located in the gym of the Otter Creek Church of Christ at 409 Franklin Road, Brentwood, TN.

Q. What are your sale hours?

A. Our public sale will begin on Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Our half-price sale will begin at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday and will run until 2:00 p.m.

Q. What is done with the money that is made at the sale?

A. 100% of our sale proceeds go toward the children's ministry at Otter Creek and to the Otter Creek Preschool and Kindergarten. We raised over \$30,000 for the new playground constructed at our Franklin Road campus, and we are now working to help build the new kindergarten wing.

Q. What type of payment do you accept?

A. We only accept checks with valid i.d. or cash at our sale. We realize we could probably make more money if we accepted credit cards. However, we do not believe in promoting the idea of debt, and we also do not want to pay the fees the credit card companies would charge us.

Q. How long have you been doing this sale?

A. Our first sale was held in the fall of 2006 and we had roughly 100 consignors. We made \$9,000.

Q. How can I find out about future sales?

A. Visit our website and join our mailing list. You will be notified of upcoming sales and will also receive a reminder postcard in the mail before each sale event.

Q. How can I become a consignor?

A. Our sale has quickly grown since we began in the fall of 2006. We now reach the maximum consignor capacity at each sale. For this reason, we allow all our previous consignors to have the first chance to register. If there are any remaining consignor spots open, we will post them on our website one month before the sale begins. If there are no spots available we will begin a waiting list. If and when spots open up, those on the waiting list will be notified in order.

Q. How can I become a volunteer at the sale?

A. Visit our website and go to the "volunteer" section. Any available shifts will be listed and you can register for a time slot. If you work a minimum of four hours, you are qualified to shop at the workers' early shopping time at 5 p.m. on the Thursday night prior to our public sale.

Q. How can I get more information about the Otter Creek Church?

A. We would love to have you join the family at Otter Creek! It is a wonderful community of believers who love the Lord and each other.
